A VIKING BY ANY OTHER NAME.....

Following a recent request for a list of authentic names I decided to rewrite several lists I found in my files. Apart from Vikings and Saxons I have included Welsh, Scottish, Irish and Norman names to give some variety. When choosing an authentic name it is sometimes easier if the new name starts with the same letter as your modern name.

THE VIKINGS

Most Vikings had only given names. If they had a surname it was usually their fathers name plus '-sson' for a man or '-dottar' for a woman. If a woman remained prominent after her husbands death, her children might be known as '-rson' or '-dottar'. Families sometimes alternated the name of the eldest child, thus Ulf Njalsson would be both the father and son of Njal Ulfsson. Nicknames were far more common. The giving of a nickname was a serious matter and created a bond between giver and reciever. The newly named person could claim a gift or favour from the giver, even if the name was derogatory.

THE ANGLO-SAXONS

Like the Vikings the Anglo-Saxons had only given names. If it was necessary to distinguish between two people with the same name the occupation or home village would be added (Aelfric the potter, Hrothgar of Drayton). A married woman would add her husband's name (e.g. Edith, Oslac's wife). During and after the reign of Cnut some Saxons adopted the Viking custom of using the father's name with the '-sson' suffix.

Next we come to our Celtic neighbours the Welsh, Scots and Irish. Although often regarded as barbarians by the Anglo-Saxons, they had in fact been christians for much longer and this explains the lack of personal names using the names of the Gods. Individuals could be distinguished by occupation, nickname, origins or by naming ones family (Aflog son of Bran, son of Cynan etc.) as far back as nessecary. Women did not change their name on marriage but could be referred to as someones wife as well as her own lineage and origins (e.g. Gwenllian, Teilo's wife, daughter of Idris).

But when Edward the Confessor returned from exile in Normandy to take the English crown in 1042, they became regular visitors. Many Norman churchmen, administrators and warriors served in England. Some were responsible for reorganising the defences along the Welsh border. Norman mercenaries or unit commanders could appear in any show with a dateline of 1045 or later. As an 'aristocratic' class, they would be known by their title or landholding (Sir Guy of Canterbury or Eustace of Rouen).
