Re: Proposal for ratification of <u>Rodents of Runnymede</u> as a new group of the NFPS

- 1. Group name: Rodents of Runnymede
- 2. Group colours: Green and white with red Dragon and red or brown rune band concentric with shield circumference (no rune band = affiliated guests)
- 3. Group location: N.W. Surrey, S. E. Berks, S.W. London
- 4. Meetings/training venue: c/o Lords of Albion, Royal Holloway University of London, Egham, Surrey
- 5. Group identity: Vikings (Norman)
- 6. Leadership structure: Leading council of three
- i) Training Officer
 - -Regulates training sessions
 - -Ensures that fighters are safe and competent
 - -Is a trained first aider
- -All training and combat matters are referred to the training officer
- ii) Communications Secretary
- -Maintains communication between the group and the NFPS main administration
- -Distributes a newsletter within the group and also news from the NFPS

- -Handles membership and group booking matters
- iii) Group Treasurer
 - -Maintains the group budget and finances
 - -Reports to Society Treasurer Annually
 - -Handles claims money and membership money

In areas of general policy (i.e. not relating specifically to their particular jurisdiction), each of the three posts hold equal powers in a 1:1 decision making process.

All three members of the council are authorised signatories for the group account.

The council may delegate one person from the council to speak for the group at Jarl's meetings.

- 7. Authenticity: Pete James has advised us in the past on authenticity matters and continues to do so. We see no present need to change this.
- 8. Miscellaneous: Membership of the group is primarily designed for graduate ex-members of Lords of Albion, Royal Holloway University of London Battle Re-enactment Society. Local initiates into the gentle art of re-enactment combat from outside the College are welcome as provisional members, and will be able to borrow combat equipment from Lords of Albion and train at Royal Holloway. Any people willing to do Living History are also welcome, although they should bear in mind firstly, that the group is primarily combat oriented and secondly, that all present equipment belongs to Lords of Albion rather than Rodents of Runnymede.
